

## Successful projects announced under Building Better Regions Fund - Round One - Infrastructure Projects

Senator the Honourable Fiona Nash announced on the 4th August, 110 rural, regional and remote projects that have successfully gained funding under the Infrastructure Projects stream of Round One of the Building Better Regions Fund (BBRF). A total amount of \$219.5 million has been invested in these projects.

Round One of the Infrastructure Projects stream was heavily oversubscribed with 545 applications received. RDA Pilbara is pleased to see that the following two organisations were successful in their funding applications:

- Shire of Ashburton - \$9, 082, 620 - Pilbara Regional Class IV Waste Management Facility. The construction of a new waste management facility in Onslow to accept regional Class I to IV domestic, mining and industrial waste; and
- Juluwarlu Group Aboriginal Corporation - \$255, 851 - Juluwarlu Group Archive and Cultural Maintenance Centre. The construction of a stand-alone open-plan workspace and archive facility including an insulated roof/ceiling and integrated communications and cabling system to support the work of the Indigenous cultural and heritage centre.
