

Stronger Communities Programme Round 5—OPEN

Federal Member for Durack, Melissa Price invites community organisations to submit an application for a local infrastructure projects.

The Stronger Communities Programme supports the Australian Government’s commitment to deliver social benefits in communities across Australia. Round 5 of the programme will provide \$22.65 million to fund small capital projects in each of the 151 federal electorates.

Each electorate has total funding of up to \$150,000 that can be allocated to successful applications. A maximum of 20 projects will be funded in each electorate.

The grant amount will be up to 50 % of eligible project costs (grant percentage).

- The minimum grant amount is \$2,500.
- The maximum grant amount is \$20,000.
