The West Pilbara Communities for Children (WPC4C) initiative, funded by the Department of Social Services, supports the Ranger for Life (R4L) programme being run by the Aboriginal Biodiversity Conservation (ABC) Foundation Ltd in Tom Price.

The programme aims to support vulnerable and disadvantaged Aboriginal children aged between 3 and 12 and their parents and guardians by providing a link between the environment, Aboriginal culture and childhood education. The ABC Foundation is currently working through the process of gaining evidence-based status for the programme.
